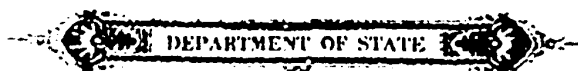

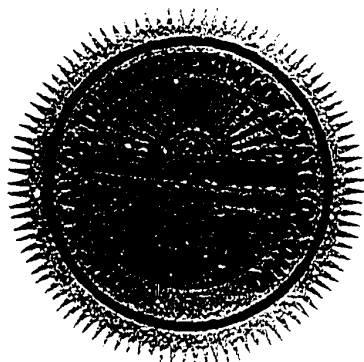

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATIONOFCOMMUNICATION EXHIBITS, INC.

The undersigned, Kenneth F. Seminatore, desiring to form a corporation for profit under the general corporation laws of Ohio, does hereby certify that:

FIRST: The name of the Corporation shall be: COMMUNICATION EXHIBITS, INC.

SECOND: The principal office of the Corporation in the State of Ohio is to be located at:

4001 Richner Avenue
Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Ohio 44113

THIRD: The purpose for which the Corporation is formed is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be formed under Sections 1701.01 to 1701.98, inclusive, of the Ohio Revised Code including without limitation, the design, manufacture, construction and sale or lease of promotional exhibits and all activities relating thereto.

FOURTH: The number of shares which the Corporation is authorized to have outstanding is 100 shares of Common Stock without par value.

FIFTH: The amount of stated capital with which the Corporation will begin business is \$500.00.

SIXTH: No holders of any class of shares of the Corporation shall have any pre-emptive right to purchase or have offered to them for purchase any shares of other securities of the Corporation.

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SEVENTH: The Corporation may from time to time, pursuant to authorization by the Board of Directors and without action by the shareholders, purchase or otherwise acquire shares of the Corporation of any class or classes in such manner, upon such terms and in such amounts as the Board of Directors shall determine; subject, however, to such limitation or restriction, if any, as is contained in the express terms of any class of shares of the Corporation outstanding at the time of the purchase or acquisition in question.

EIGHTH: A director or officer of the Corporation shall not be disqualified by his office from dealing or contracting with the Corporation as a vendor, purchaser, employee, agent or otherwise; nor shall any transaction, contract or other act of the Corporation be void or voidable or in any way affected or invalidated by reason of the fact that any director or officer, or any firm in which such director or officer is a member, or any corporation of which such director or officers is a shareholder, director or officer, is in any way interested in such transaction, contract or other act, provided the fact that such director, officer, firm or corporation is so interested shall be disclosed or shall be known to the Board of Directors or such members thereof as shall be present at any meeting of the Board of Directors at which action upon any such transaction, contract or other act shall be taken; nor shall any such director or officer be accountable or responsible to the Corporation for or in respect of any such transaction, contract or other act of the Corporation or for any gains or profits realized by him by reason of the fact that he or any firm of which he is a member or any corporation of which he is a shareholder, director or officer is interested in such transaction, contract or other act; and any such director may be counted in determining the existence of a quorum at any meeting of the Board of Directors of the Corporation which shall authorize or take action in respect of any such transaction, contract or other act, and may vote thereat to authorize, ratify or approve any such transaction, contract or other act with like force and effect as if he or any firm of which he is a member or any corporation of which he is a shareholder, director or officer were not interested in such transaction, contract or other act.

NINTH: Notwithstanding any provision of the Ohio Revised Code now or hereafter in force requiring for any purpose the vote, consent, waiver or release of the holders of shares entitling them to exercise two-thirds, or any other proportion, of the voting power of the Corporation or of any class or classes of shares thereof, such action, unless otherwise expressly required by statute or by these Articles, may be taken by the vote,

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consent, waiver or release of the holders of shares entitling them to exercise a majority of the voting power of the Corporation or of such class or classes.

TENTH: Any and every statute of the State of Ohio hereafter enacted, whereby the rights, powers or privileges of corporations or of the shareholders of corporations organized under the laws of the State of Ohio are increased or diminished or in any way affected, or whereby effect is given to the action taken by any number, less than all, of the shareholders of any such corporation, shall apply to the Corporation and shall be binding not only upon the Corporation but upon every shareholder of the Corporation to the same extent as if such statute had been in force at the date of filing these Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation in the Office of the Secretary of State of Ohio.

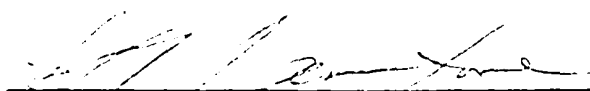

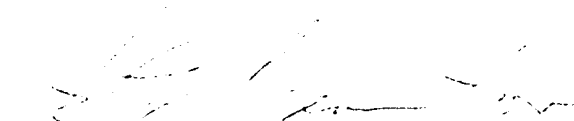
